Details of Staff Club

1. Any person who is a teaching faculty (permanent teachers and teachers-on-contract including librarian) of any of the departments shall be the member of Staff Club.
2. All such members shall constitute the general body of the staff club.

Objectives of Staff Club

- a. To encourage recreational activities of the staff members.
- b. To facilitate positive interaction among the teachers of various departments of the college.
- c. To carry out expert talks on various topics for the benefit of teachers.
- d. To conduct an annual get-together cum cultural night of the club members and their families.
- e. To recognize the achievements of the faculty members and their children.
- f. To give a token of love on the special occasions of club members (Wedding and house warming) on behalf of all staff members.
- g. To organise a retirement/send-off function.
- h. To conduct a staff-tour every academic year with all members.
- i. To conduct/introduce various activities/scheme for the benefit of staff club members.

The Executive Committee of the Staff Club

1. President, General Secretary, Joint Secretary and Treasurer of the club shall be elected in the General body.
2. There will be seven executive members, including President, General Secretary, Joint Secretary and Treasurer. The remaining three members will be a woman representative, a member from teachers on contract and former general secretary.
3. Amendments in the policies of the staff club passed by the executive members shall be discussed in the General Body, and will be in effect only after the approval of the majority in the General Body meeting. Recommendations of the General Body shall be incorporated after the discussions.

Quorum

1. There should be minimum 75% attendance in the executive committee
2. The minimum quorum for General body is 60% of attendance

Tenure of the Staff Club

- a) The tenure of the elected staff club shall be of two years.
- b) The first general body of the Staff Club members shall be convened before 30 July of every academic year
- c) The yearly accounts of the Staff Club should be presented and approved in the General Body of July.
- d) The new committee will be elected in the first general body.

Funds of the Club

1. The working fund of the Staff Club is the subscription of its members.
2. A monthly subscription of staff club members shall be collected. Permanent teachers subscription is 200/- per month, while teachers on contract shall pay 50/- rupees every month.
3. The subscription amount shall be deducted from the salary of the club members or as decided by the principal and the staff club committee.
4. A separate joint bank account (Principal and General Secretary) for staff club will be maintained.

Definitions
