CSIR UGC NET June 2016 Notification - Exam on 19th June 2016 (Download PDF)

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Eligibility Criteria: Candidates must have done 4 year program (B. Tech, B. E, B. Pharma, MBBS, M. Sc) with at least 55 % from a recognized university. The final year candidates of M. Sc or have done 10 + 2+3 years are also eligible. Or bachelor's degree in science, engineering or in any other discipline, they are also eligible for it.

DETAILS FOR CSIR NET JUNE 2016

Age Limit

- Candidate's age should not be more than 28 years as on 1st January 2015 for **JRF (NET)**.
- There is no age limit for it for LS (NET).

Note: Age relaxation is applicable as per government rule up to 5 years for SC/ST/OBC/Physical Handicapped/Visually Handicapped and female applicant.

CSIR-UGC NET Exam for Science stream is conducted by CSIR in the following areas

- Chemical Sciences
- Earth Sciences
- Life Sciences
- Mathematical Sciences
- Physical Sciences
- Engineering Sciences

CSIR UGC NET pattern for the Single Paper MCQ test

The MCQ test paper is carries a maximum of 200 marks for each subject.

Duration of exam will be three hours.

The paper will be divided in three parts (A, B & C) as per syllabus & Scheme of Exam, mentioned as bellow:

Part 'A':

- It is common to all subjects.
- This part will contain questions pertaining to General Aptitude with emphasis on logical reasoning, graphical analysis, analytical and numerical ability, quantitative comparison, series formation, puzzles etc.

Part 'B':

- It contain subject-related conventional Multiple Choice questions (MCQs), usually covering the topics given in the syllabus

Part 'C':

- It contains higher value questions that may test the candidate's knowledge of scientific concepts and/or application of the scientific concepts.

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- The questions will be of analytical nature where a candidate is expected to apply the scientific knowledge to arrive at the solution to the given scientific problem

How to Apply

- The interested candidates have to apply only through online mode before 1st March 2016 from the official website of CSIR.
- Fill required basic information.
- Send the hard copy of the application form along with all the required documents and e-challan at "The Sr. Controller of Examination of CSIR, HRDG" on or before 7th March 2016.

Application Fees

The candidates have to deposit the examination fee at any branch of the Indian Bank across the country.

- General category- Rs. 1000/-
- OBC/NCL category- Rs. 500/-
- SC/ST/PH/VH category- 250/-
