More girls and women than ever before have access to higher education and the gender gap is closing in higher education as well. . Successful education policies have helped women constitute 40% of the global labour force in the formal sector. Nevertheless, there are still considerable differences in the allocation of work and pay between the sexes, especially in the labour market: What remains unchanged is that women worldwide perform the largest share of unpaid and informal work, are less common in the upper hierarchies of businesses and earn on average about 24% less (for equal work) from a global perspective. As these differences are primarily the result of private sector decisions made in the labour market, they are difficult to address directly through official development cooperation.

Here, Vocational training can serve as a central lever in gender equity programs. With an intention to empower women and thus to attain gender equity, the Women Cell of the college organized a Workshop in Liquid Painting on 02/01/2015. 60 students from different programs participated.
