

FUNDRAISING CAPAIGN TO THE UPLIFTEMENT OF FLOOD AFFECTED PEOPLE 2018

A REPORT

Kerala experienced an abnormally high rainfall from 1 June 2018 to 19 August 2018. This resulted in severe flooding in 13 out of 14 districts in the State. As per IMD data, Kerala received 2346.6 mm of rainfall from 1 June 2018 to 19 August 2018 in contrast to an expected 1649.5 mm of rainfall. This rainfall was about 42% above the normal. Further, the rainfall over Kerala during June, July and 1st to 19th of August was 15%, 18% and 164% respectively, above normal. This affected the people. This abnormal rain and flood affected the people badly and they lost everything.

Students of EMEA College with the leadership of teachers went for a fundraising event on 12-09-2018. They approached the people of flood unaffected areas and collect donations in money and kind. They collected Rs. 150000 in money and so many essential articles in kind. The donations collected were distributed among the flood affected areas in Nilambur and Wayanad.
