The Principal's Club is a unique program established under the Students Advisory Scheme of the college. The maximum intake of Advanced Learners will be restricted to 50. Out of which, 10% of seats will be reserved for SC/ST students.PH category is also considered.

## Principal's Club: A Brief Note

The Principal's Club is a unique programme established under the Students Advisory Scheme of the college in the academic year 2018-2019. The programme is fully funded and monitored by the institution.

## **Constitution of the Club**

The maximum intake of Advanced Learners will be restricted to 50. Out of which, 10% seats will be reserved for SC/ST students. Proportionate representation for students from PH category is also considered.

## **Selection Process:**

The members of the Club titled 'Advanced Learners' are selected from the newly enrolled first year students of Under Graduate programme through an entry level Entrance Examination. Special question papers are set having proportionate questions to check the proficiency of



students in English language skills, GK and Current Affairs and the subject of their Plus Two Intermediate course. Candidates for these clubs are selected giving equal weightage for their performance in the entrance examination and the percentage they obtained for the Plus Two examination.

## **Entrance Test: Details**

- There will be 50 objective type questions
  - > 13 questions for checking English Language Skills
  - > 12 Questions from GK and Current Affairs
  - > 25 questions from the Plus Two Subject
- Each question carries 2 Marks.

## Advanced Learners Entrance Test Files 2020 – 2021

As the outbreak of Covid- 19, the Entrance test for selecting the Advanced Learners/ Principal's Club members was conducted online using Google Form in the Online Quiz mode. As the college is allotted two batches of BVoc courses, students from those classes also took part in the test. Due to network connectivity issues, some of the students were not able to appear for the test. But, as the programme has to go on, the committee for entrance test has gone forward with its plans and selected the members. The meeting of the committee with the Principal has come to a resolution that special and genuine cases can be taken in to

- 7. Make yourself available in a place with good network data connectivity.
- 8. No negative marking is included. So, attempt all the questions so as to score good marks and get selected.
