


The department of Economics organised another Report of Webinar on "Methodological Issues in Impact Studies" on 25-08-2020 at 09.30 AM to 12.30 PM.






### **Department of English:**







### **Debating Club:**


### DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE


### **Department of Microbiology**



## **ED CLUB**



NCC unit of EMEA College of Arts and Science Kondotty observed Pulwama day on Sunday 14th February 2020 at the College campus.


They paid floral tribute and lighted candles to the soldiers who lost their lives in the 2019 Pulwama attack.


## Four Day Premarital Counseling

The course was initiated on April 29, 2020 and extended to 30 September 2020. It was during the pandemic Covid-19 that Coursera launched a new scheme to collaborate with colleges and EMEA College of Arts and Science Kondotty was the second college in Kerala that grabbed this opportunity to work with Coursera to learn and achieve certificates from international universities. The college successfully completed 1500 enrolments and the courses were offered for Students of the college, Staff of the college, alumni of the college and the general public.

# COURSERA

Coursera is an American MOOC provider founded in 2012 by Stanford University's computer science professors Andrew Ng and Daphne Koller that offers massive open online courses (MOOC), specializations, degrees, professional and master track courses. Coursera works with universities and other organizations to offer online courses, certifications, and degrees in a variety of subjects.

Coursera courses last approximately four to twelve weeks, with one to two hours of video lectures a week. These courses provide quizzes, weekly exercises, peer-graded and reviewed assignments, an optional Honors assignment and sometimes a final project or exam to complete the course.[21] Courses are also provided on-demand, in which case users can take their time in completing the course with all of the material available at once. As of May 2015, Coursera offered 104 on-demand courses it also provides guided projects which are short 2-3 hour projects that can be done.



### **Execution of the Program**

Different WhatsApp groups were formed for the execution of the program. Eight WhatsApp groups were formed for the participants, including an exclusive group for Admin Panel, Staff of EMEA College, PG students and the general public.



Lt. Abdul Rasheed, Nodal Officer of the program, briefed about the licensing process of EMEA College Sponsored Coursera Program and EMEA College's achievement in getting 1000 enrolment slots for offering online courses of reputed universities free of cost. In order to log into various advanced courses in different subjects like health, business, humanities, commerce, science and much more courses, a student may simply provide his/her email ID. The students

have to forward it to the college faculty through Google form to get the invitation link to join. And once it is received the student can login to any of the courses offered in Coursera. The further step includes either logging in if you already have an account or signing up a coursera account using the website <u>www.coursera.org</u>. Once a student has logged in, he/she has to click on the 'browse the catalogue' option to find 5000+ courses. Once a course is selected the student will be directed to a page where he/she can enrol it for free (courses sponsored by EMEA). He/she can browse through the course structure that gives a detailed information regarding the duration of learning, study materials and assignments. The student after clicking on the 'go to courses' tab can listen to the lectures of the world class professors of top universities across the globe.

Once the course is completed the student will be awarded with certificates of the reputed international universities. Approximately 1000 students of EMEA College have enrolled to the course and majority have had successful outcomes. EMEA College in affiliation with Coursera gave students opportunity to enrol in the different world class university courses. Through Coursera, students could invest time and effort to accomplish reputed certificates online using quarantine period effectively facilitating ways to learn during school and college classroom teaching was on its pause.






### INTERNAL QUALITY ASSSUARANCE CELL (IQAC)
