### EMEA COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE COLLEGE UNION REPORT 2014-19

The college union election was held as per the guidelines issued by the University of Calicut in strict adherence to Lyngthau Committee report. The following students were elected to the college union by secret ballot system based on simple majority system. The election machinery at college level constitutive a returning officer, one or two assistant returning officers, presiding officers (equaling to the number of polling stations), polling officers and polling assistants. The college union election is a model of general elections in the country. Notification, nominations, scrutiny, publication of valid list of candidates, withdrawal, campaign, polling, counting of votes, and declaration of results are the main stages in the electoral process. The student representatives belong to three categories; General Seats, Class Representatives, Association Secretaries. Two seats are reserved for Women; Vice Chairman and Joint Secretary. A report of the composition and major activities of college union during the last five years is given below.




