ACADEMICS AND RESULTS OF ENTRANCE EXAMS

The department of Biotechnology has a very good academic record and rating in the results of the students in the university examinations and PG entrance examinations. It has secured about 85% pass in BSc. Biotechnology programme. 4 students of this department has qualified Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi (JNU) All India combined entrance exam for MSc Biotechnology. 6 students qualified entrance exams for MSc Food Technology and Biotechnology of Calicut University, Kannur University and MG University.

Research

The faculties of Biotechnology department have attended various seminars. Dr. K. Mashhoor, Published 7 gene sequence in GenBank of National Centre for Biotechnology (NCBI), USA.

The Department has made Research collaboration with, Endocrinology Laborotory, Dept. of Zoology, University of Calicut in Probiotics of Fish.
