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Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

In order to advance the quality of education in higher educational centres, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has proposed all accredited higher educational institutions to form Internal Quality Assurance Cells (IQAC) to monitor the quality improvement initiatives of the institution. This is to ensure that the long-term objectives of the institution are fulfilled in a time-bound manner.

Based on the positive recommendations of the NAAC peer team in 2020, the institution initiated a discussion with all the stakeholders regarding the present limitations of the institution and the changes to be adapted in accordance with the current academic scenario. Incorporating all suggestions, the IQAC formulated a long-term strategic plan, 'Vision 2025' identifying the thrust areas, viz., institutionalization of research activities through a separate research centre with quality research officer, centre for Professional Development, Awards grants and incentives for highly performed teachers, digital campus, Student Support, skill acquisition, eco -consciousness and sustainability, community outreach, gender sensitivity, quality enhancement of faculty and up gradation of departments.

Green Campus Initiatives was started with the intention of greening the campus which is a dry area sprawled over laterite rock all over. One of the ambitious projects is to make a canopy pathway through the heart of the campus with selected trees on both sides of the road which is a five-year project. A walk-through nature will boost the confidence of teachers and students. Above all, this will give ample aesthetic looks to the campus.

There will be three levels of target achievement analysis Short term, Midterm and Vision accomplishment. A structure has been formulated by the institution to identify and monitor the implementation progress.



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From Local to Global: Internationalization of the Institution

- Ensure that higher education is accessible to the deprived sections of the society
- To be the arch through which the arena of internationalization is sought

Curricular Aspects

- To be an Autonomous college by 2024

- The percentage of teachers using LMS and ICT will be brought to 100 by 2022.
- Teachers with PhD will be given priority for appointment. Faculty members are advised to register for PhD so as to have the percentage of teachers with doctorate above 75 by 2025.
- Students from outside the state and country will be given admission to various programmes in the college.



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- Centralised Internal Evaluation (CIE) will be conducted on regular basis and the toppers in each semester will be honoured.
- Online evaluation methods will also be adopted.
- For academic and administrative requirements EMBASE Pro Suit Online system is installed

Research, Innovation and Extensions

- Centre for Research and Publication is established.
