1. Methodology

This survey report is descriptive and analytical in nature. The data were collected from the employers known to various departments. A convenient sample method was used. The respective departments did the sample selection and data collection. The data were collected by the 5-point scale questionnaire prepared by IQAC. A copy of the concerned syllabus was also handed over to the employers along with the questionnaire for ready reference. For the analysis of data – the descriptive statistics like average, percentage and tabular and diagrammatic tools were used. The data were analyzed with the statistical software IBM-PASW (SPSS) (Trial Version). The report is prepared by IQAC. A copy of the report will submit to the concerned departments and also place before the academic council of the college for necessary decisions.

1.1. Overview

For the curriculum feedback analysis from the category of employer, the data were collected from 15 employers from various sectors. Out of the total samples of employers, 6.6% are representing government sector, 80% represents private sector and remaining 13.3% represents public private participation.

Out of the total employers, 25.7% examined and put their opinion on UG programme while 52.3% employers opined on PG programmes and the remaining 20% validated the Certificate programmes offered by the college.




Figure 1: Percentage of Employers opined on Programmes




Fig. 2: Opinion on Academic Flexibility
