Agenda No. 1 and 2: Approval of Agenda:

The committee learned all the recommendations and directions of meeting of Anti-Ragging Committee for monitoring measures to prevent ragging in higher education institutions held on 19/01/2024 at UGC Main office, New Delhi and decided to conduct awareness classes and seminars that enhance the behavioral qualities of the senior students with a holistic approach. In order to maintain a cordial relationship among the junior and senior students, it is decided to strengthen the student's relationship in a mentor – mentee approach by conducting various programmes.
