PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING

Agenda No. 1 and 2: Approval of Agenda:

The Chairman of the committee, Principal welcomed all members to the meeting. The agenda was approved without any amendments.

Agenda No.3: The members were highly satisfied and appreciated the activities of the anti ragging committee on the proactive approach taken in the college especially during the commencement of first year classes in the beginning of each academic year. The committee learned all the recommendations and directions of meeting of Anti-Ragging Committee for monitoring measures to prevent ragging in higher education institutions held on 19/01/2024 at UGC Main office, New Delhi and decided to conduct awareness classes and seminars that enhance the behavioral qualities of the senior students with a holistic approach. In order to maintain a cordial relationship among the junior and senior students, it is decided to strengthen the student's relationship in a mentor -mentee approach by conducting various programmes. According to the previous recommendations of the committee to provide counseling sessions to groom mental make-up in the positive directions especially for the bad-eggs of the classes, the college has appointed a college counselor Ms Keerthana (under Jeevani Programme, Govt. of Kerala) for the same. Also, a meeting has been conducted with the department of Kerala police, district magistrate and anti-ragging cell of the colleges on 8th March 2024 as part of anti-ragging awareness initiative and decided to conduct an awareness programme led by the district magistrate and Kerala police in the month of June 2024 in the college premise. Moreover, the anti-ragging committee extended its whole hearted support for implementing the recommendations of the meeting.

The anti-ragging cell of the college has taken a number of measures to prevent ragging. These measures include:

- Awareness programs:

The cell conducts awareness programs for students and staff on the issue of ragging. These programs are aimed at sensitizing students to the harmful effects of ragging and to encourage them to report any incidents of ragging that they may witness. In the beginning of each academic year all students and their parents are given the anti-ragging awareness and a declaration is got signed by the students and their parents regarding the same.

- Counselling:

The college under the counsellor provides counselling to students who have been affected by various mental issues. This counselling helps students to cope with the trauma of unlawful activities caused to them and to rebuild their lives.

- **Strict disciplinary action:**

The cell with the support of the discipline committee takes strict disciplinary action against students who are found guilty of any activities including ragging. This action may include suspension or expulsion from the college.

- **Collaboration with law enforcement agencies:**

The cell works closely with law enforcement agencies to investigate and prosecute cases of ragging if any. The anti-ragging cell is committed to creating a ragging-free environment in the college with zero tolerance. The cell's measures have been effective to eliminate incidence of ragging in the college. However, the cell remains vigilant and continues to work towards the goal of a completely ragging-free campus.

Here are some additional measures that the anti-ragging cell can take to prevent ragging:

- **Increase surveillance:**

The college has increased surveillance on campus, especially in areas where ragging is likely to occur, such as hostels, canteens, and libraries. This has been done by installing new CCTV cameras in this year apart from the previous ones.


- **Encourages students to report ragging:**

The cell encourages students to report ragging by creating a safe and confidential environment for them to do so. This is done by providing students with the contact information of trusted faculty members or staff.

- **Work with parents:**

The cell work with parents to educate them about the issue of ragging and to encourage them to talk to their children about it. Parents can play an important role in preventing ragging by being aware of the signs and symptoms of ragging and by intervening early if they suspect that their child is being affected.

By taking these measures, the anti-ragging cell has created a ragging-free environment in the college to protect students from the harmful effects of ragging. There has not been any ragging incident reported in the college this academic year by the virtue of the whole hearted support from the students and teachers community.






