## **Background of the webinar**

In this background the department hopes that a discussion on the pandemic is relevant and we have chosen the topic 'Economic impacts and challenges of the pandemic on India vis-a-vis Kerala for this webinar. The department of economics in EMEA College Kondotty is a veteran department which discusses and interfere the problems related with the all aspects of the society. After this webinar, it is expected that people may get a clear cut vision about the changes in the economy due to the pandemic Covid 19.

## **Procedure of the Webinar**

of Economics ,EMEA College Kondotty. After the presidential address Dr. Ayoob CP( Principal),delivered his principal's address. The webinar series was inaugurated by Dr. Abdul Salim. A, Professor of Economics, Kerala University. After this Keynote address was given by Dr. Abdul Azeez. NT of Aligarh Muslim University and the participants of the webinar asked different questions and their doubts were cleared. It was really a wonderful session with plenty of information about the current situations in the economy with the influence of the pandemic Covid 19. Though the webinar was schedule from 9.30 AM to 11.30 AM, it extended till 12.45 due to the active interactions of the participants .The webinar was wind up with the Vote of Thanks of Professor Abdurazaque PM, Associate Professor, EMEA College Kondotty. Feed backs of the participants were also collected through the pre designed form after winding up the webinar.

### **Highlights of the Presentation**

Covid 19 affected in all spheres of human life. It affected vulnerably both supply and demand of commodities. Due to lock down, travel restriction and social distancing the produced goods were not able to supply which in turn reduced the production and distribution of commodities. The distribution hurdle badly affected further supply. In demand side due to the reduction of employment opportunities, income and purchasing of the people decreased perpetuating further decrease in demand. On the background of shocks in demand and supply ILO warns that about half of the world workers will lose their livelihoods. The pandemic badly affected the trade sector because of the restrictions in trade. It affected the migrants by losing their jobs which in turn reflected on the remittances from foreign countries to India. In the case of foreign remittances, Kerala is bagging a major share but it will slow down because of the return of migrants from GCC countries due to the loss

of employment. It is expected that Kerala's remittance will fall about 15 percent. In the case of India remittances are expected to fall by approximate 23 percent in 2020 facing a loss of Dollar 19 billion. Socio-behavioral changes are another notable effect of this pandemic. It loosed the public trust and forward looking. As a conclusion because of the effect of Covid 19 the chain of actions and reactions will continue and it will take time to recover the economy as the previous level.
